State Fossil: Saber-Tooth Cat (1973) California designated the saber-tooth cat (*Smilodon californicus*) as the official state fossil in 1973. The carnivorous saber-tooth cats (extinct members of the cat family Felidae) flourished throughout North America from the late Eocene and early Oligocene (40 to 35 million years ago) until the close of the Pleistocene about 11,000 years ago.
