

Download Toyota Tacoma Maintenance Manual Transmission Fluid

Toyota Tacoma: How to Change Automatic Transmission Fluid. Replacing the transmission fluid is one way to ensure your gearbox stays safe. Read on to learn how to do it on the Toyota Tacoma. I have a 1996 Toyota Tacoma. Should I use GL-4 or GL-5 gear oil for the manual transmission fluid and how often should it be changed? Thank you. To change the differential and transfer case oil, you will need a drain pan, a ratchet, a 10mm hex bit socket, a 24mm socket, and a possibly a manual pump for refilling (as shown in the transmission section above). I am just getting ready to change the fluids in my 2018 TRD Sport 6MT. Looking at the Ravenol, it actually states Toyota 08885-81081 NOT 08885-81080 which I understand to be the LF fluid that Toyota recommends. I am not familiar with Toyota's part number system, so maybe 08885-81081 supersedes 08885-81080.
